ASEAN Energy Storage Cabinet Power Cooperation Project



Overview

KUALA LUMPUR, MALAYSIA (15 October 2025) – The Asian Development Bank (ADB), the World Bank Group, and the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) have launched a new financing initiative to support the ASEAN Power Grid (APG) – ASEAN’s collective effort to connect the region’s electricity networks and strengthen energy cooperation by 2045. What is the ASEAN Power Grid?

The ASEAN Power Grid is more than an infrastructure plan; it’s a regional cooperation framework that could transform how Southeast Asia powers its growth. With strong political will, innovative financing, and aligned regulations, APG can catalyze the energy transition, climate resilience, and economic competitiveness.

How does ASEAN contribute to energy security and sustainability?

Diverse Energy Resources: ASEAN possesses a wide range of energy sources, from fossil fuels to renewables, but unevenly distributed across countries.
Need for Regional Cooperation: Energy security and sustainability necessitate integrated planning and interconnection among ASEAN member states.

What is the regional blueprint for energy cooperation in ASEAN?

Regional blueprint for the energy cooperation in the ASEAN that builds on the success of APAEC Phase I: 2016-2020, sets out ambitious targets and initiatives to enhance energy security and sustainability and supports the UN SDG7.

What is the ASEAN Energy Transition & water transformation Ministry (Petra) meeting about?

Energy Transition and Water Transformation Ministry (PETRA) secretary-general Datuk Mad Zaidi Mohd Karli said the meeting had finalised major agendas, including the ASEAN Power Grid (APG) Enhanced Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) and the second phase of the ASEAN Plan of Action for Energy Cooperation (APAEC) for 2026–2030.

What is the ASEAN medium-term programme of action on energy cooperation?

ASEAN adopted the ASEAN Medium-Term Programme of Action on Energy Cooperation (1995–1999). The medium-term programme marked a shift towards a more focused and programmatic approach, identifying key cooperation areas: electricity, oil and gas, coal, new and renewable sources of energy, and energy efficiency.

How will ASEAN's Energy Cooperation be advanced under Apaec 2026–2030?

Accordingly, ASEAN's energy cooperation under APAEC 2026–2030 will be advanced through the following seven programme areas: The detailed strategies and action plans for each programme area over the five-year period are presented and discussed below. 22 ASEAN Plan of Action for Energy Cooperation (APAEC) 2026-2030
