Overview

What is a rooftop Telecom Tower?

Rooftop telecom towers, often called rooftop cell towers or roof top antenna towers, are specialized structures installed on building rooftops to support antennas and equipment for wireless communication. Typically ranging from 3 to 30 meters in height, these towers use hot-dip galvanized steel (ASTM A123) for over 30 years of durability.

How do outdoor base stations work?

Outdoor base stations integrate all essential systems into a single Integrated Cabinet, designed to endure harsh conditions like direct sunlight, rain, and extreme temperatures. These units protect the equipment while ensuring efficient functionality. Towers are crucial for mounting antennas at high elevations, ensuring wide signal reach.

Positioned closest to end users, they serve as gateways for processing customer requests and managing data flow.
