Belgian communication base station EMS latest



Overview

A consortium composed of Airbus Defence and Space and Belgacom has been awarded a major renewal contract for the Belgian nationwide Tetra network. It aims to strengthen crucial components of the core network and will provide more efficient system management and additional security. How does EMS work in Belgium?

In Belgium, the provision of prehospital emergency medical services (EMS) is assured by a network of various public and private (both non-profit and for-profit) organizations. The EMS system as a whole is overseen by Belgium's federal government, primarily by the FPS Health and the federal minister of Health.

What happens after on-scene care in Belgium?

After on-scene care, the patient will typically be transported to the emergency department (ED) of a hospital for further treatment. The responsibility of the Belgian EMS system ends with the receiving hospital taking charge of the patient. After World War I, motorized ambulances made their entry into Belgian civilian life.

How many acute hospitals in Belgium have specialized EDs?

In 2018, almost all acute Belgian hospitals (99%) had at least one site with a specialized ED. Yet several hospitals have multiple specialized EDs (on multiple sites). On 193 acute hospital sites, there were 125 sites with a specialized ED and four with a non-specialized ED.
