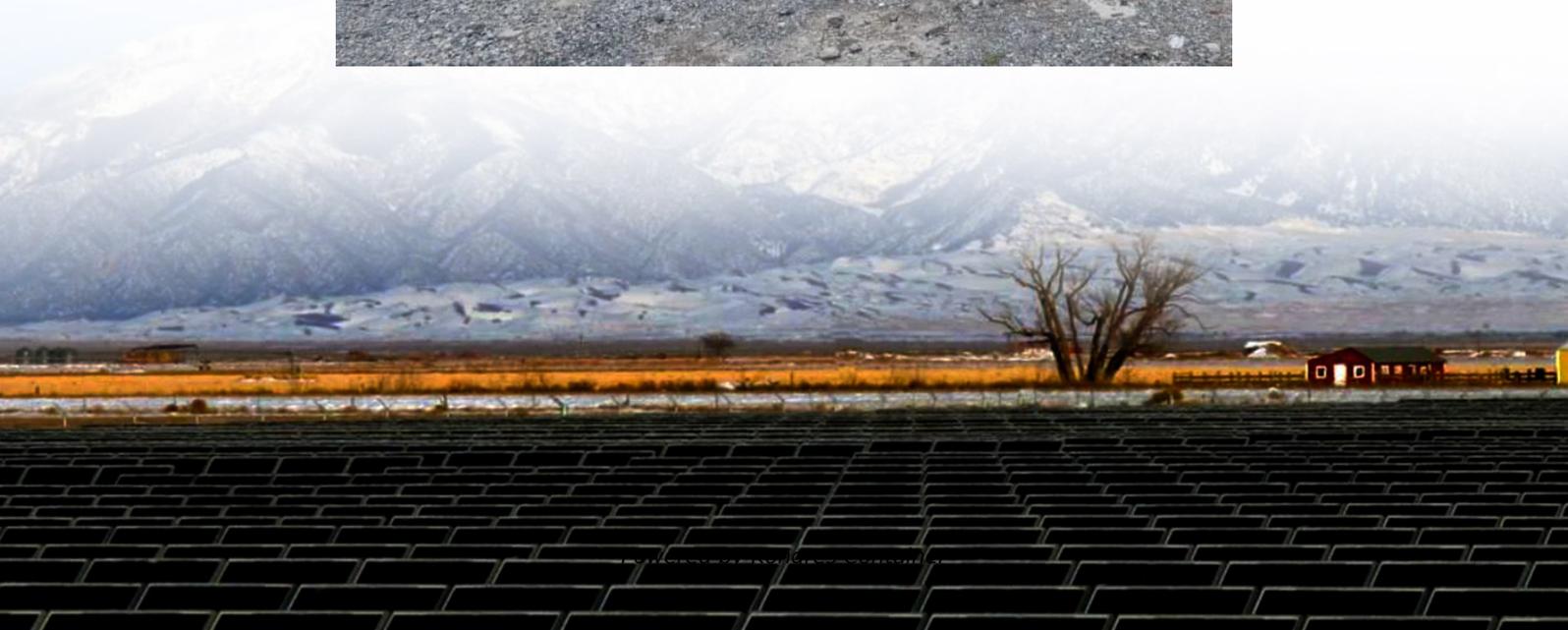

Burkina Faso new outdoor power supply



Overview

The funding will go toward building and operating an 18 MWp solar power plant in Dédougou, marking a key step in the government's drive to expand renewable energy in Africa and cut dependence on costly, carbon-intensive power sources. What changes have been made in Burkina Faso since the last iteration?

UNCIL Major changes Since the last iteration, significant progress has been made with the successive commissioning of new solar power plants in Burkina Faso in 2024, and the continuation of electrification efforts despite the security crisis. The national coverage rate has increased to 50%, compared to a national electrification rate.

Does Burkina Faso have electricity?

Bondukuy and Djigouera are small villages in the south near Bobo-Dioulasso. In the many small villages of Burkina Faso, there is usually no electricity, although every now and then you will see a solar panel or rechargeable car battery running a television or stereo, and you might find an occasional gas-operated refrigerator.

How much solar energy does Burkina Faso have?

Early solar energy. Burkina Faso benefits from daily sunlight of 5.5 kWh/m² for 3000 to 3500 hours per year, with a uniformly distributed solar resource across the national territory, yielding an
