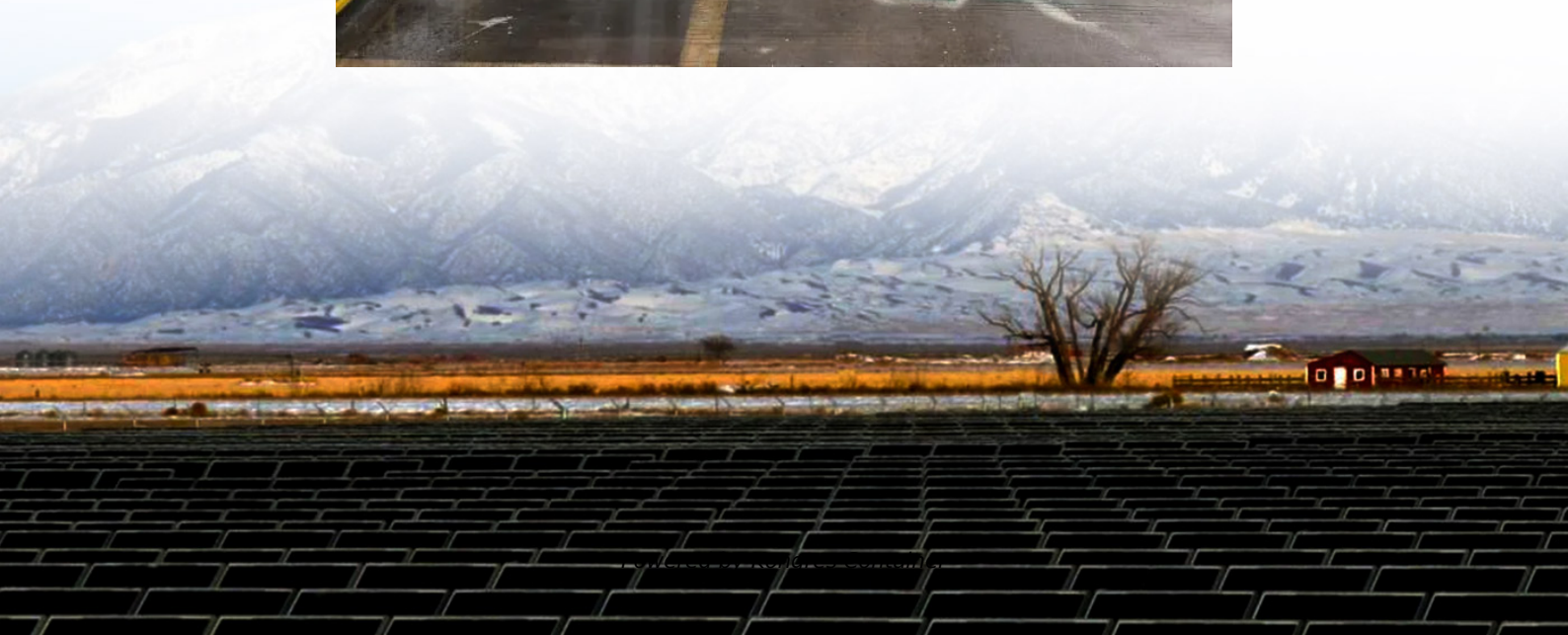


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Cambodia restricts power generation from solar panels



Overview

On January 26, 2018, the EAC issued a set of regulations to clarify the general conditions for installing and operating solar photovoltaic (PV) systems in Cambodia but capacity charges and regulations restrict Cambodians from generation from their own Solar PV even.

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Cambodia has one of the highest solar energy potentials in the region. The country plans to significantly scale up capacity in the coming decades to strengthen the energy grid and reach its net-zero emissions goals. Phnom Penh, Cambodia — Cambodia is on track to significantly boost its solar energy share, with new figures projecting solar to make up 7% of the country's electricity supply by 2025. This equates to a total installed capacity of 530.14 megawatts (MW) —a major leap from 3.2% in 2023 and 4.6% in.
