A typical American household needs a 10-kilowatt (kW) system to adequately power their home, which costs \$28,241 in 2025. As of 2025, the average cost of residential solar panels in the U.S. is between \$15,000 and \$25,000 before incentives. This typically translates to about \$2.50 to \$3.50 per watt of installed capacity (more on price per watt below). The total price depends.
