These Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS), also referred to as "concentrator units," are being placed at Cueto 220, Bayamo.

The Cuban regime plans to eliminate daytime blackouts by 2026 with 2,000 MW of solar energy. Additionally, it aims to reduce the consumption of fossil fuels. Amid one of the most significant energy crises in recent decades, the Cuban regime offers the "hope" of eliminating daytime blackouts by 2026.

The Cuban government has unveiled a bold initiative to introduce one thousand megawatts (MW) of solar energy into the National Electric System (SEN) by 2025. This effort, which involves establishing approximately fifty photovoltaic parks across the nation, aims to address Cuba's persistent energy.

These photovoltaic parks are part of a plan presented by the Cuban Ministry of Energy and Mines (Minem) in March 2024, which proposes the installation of a total of 92 photovoltaic parks by 2028, with a total installed capacity of 2,000 MW (Figure 1). 1. Cuba plans to build a total of 92.

Yet Cuba's power outages increased by 23% in 2023 despite adding 450MW solar capacity. What's really going wrong?

Cuba currently operates 186 renewable parks generating 25% of its electricity. But here's the kicker - less than 15% have proper energy storage systems. "We're basically throwing away.

But here's a twist: Cuba's capital is quietly becoming a hotspot for energy storage innovation. The National Energy Havana Energy Storage project isn't just another tech initiative—it's a lifeline for a nation tackling energy poverty and climate change. But who's paying attention?

Let's break it.
