Samoa boosts solar power with a \$2.8M ADB loan, increasing capacity by 50% using bifacial modules, cutting diesel imports, and stabilizing energy costs. Samoa is enhancing its main solar farm with a USD 2.8 million loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB), increasing capacity from 4.2 MW to 6 MW.

How long will Samoa's solar project last?

The project expected to last more than 20 years is spread out over three sites in the country's main islands, Upolu and Savai'i. "Today, we are opening Samoa's first solar system, without storage, that can be connected to the grid, to run in parallel with other energy sources like diesel generators.

How will Samoa's 546kwp solar PV system benefit the government?

The installation of Samoa's 546kWp solar PV grid-connected system is expected to provide significant benefits to the government of Samoa by reducing the use of diesel by around 190,000 litres p.a and realizing costs savings of approximately SAT570,000 per annum in a country which generates 60% of its electricity from diesel.

What is Samoa's Energy Initiative?

The initiative will involve the expansion of solar farms, battery storage systems, and energy efficiency programs to support domestic and commercial energy needs. Samoa currently relies heavily on imported diesel for electricity generation, making it vulnerable to fluctuating global oil prices.
