Energy storage capacity expansion costs



Overview

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Figure ES-2 shows the overall capital cost for a 4-hour battery system based on those projections, with storage costs of \$147/kWh, \$243/kWh, and \$339/kWh in 2035 and \$108/kWh, \$178/kWh, and \$307/kWh in 2050 (values in 2024\$). To accurately reflect the changing cost of new electric power generators in the Annual Energy Outlook 2025 (AEO2025), EIA commissioned Sargent & Lundy (S&L) to evaluate the overnight capital cost and performance characteristics for 19 electric generator types.
