Senate Republicans on Tuesday abandoned their effort to impose new taxes on solar and wind energy. Text released by the Senate Rules Committee no longer includes a new tax on solar and wind projects if some of their components come from China. The excise tax had been a last-minute addition to the.

The draft bill released in the early morning hours on Saturday contains a surprising provision imposing a new excise tax on applicable wind and solar facilities that receive “material assistance” from an FEOC in excess of a stipulated threshold. This threshold varies by project type and is defined.

Even as 2024 was a banner year for clean technology deployment in the United States with wind and solar generation reaching a record 17 percent of U.S. electricity generation and overtaking coal generation for the first time, utility-scale battery storage capacity increasing by 66 percent, and.
