Who dominates the 5G market in Finland?

The 5G market in Finland is dominated by three key players, Elisa, Telia, and DNA. The coverage of 5G in the country is challenged by a vast contrast between urban and rural areas.

Does Finland have a telecommunications sector?

Telecommunications in Finland, as indicated by a 2022 European Commission index, highlight the country's significant role in the EU's digital sector. Finland has a high concentration of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) specialists and robust training programs, leading to notable expertise in technologies like AI and cloud computing.

How many radio stations are there in Finland?

Finland is one of the most advanced information societies in the world. There are 200 newspapers; 320 popular magazines, 2,100 professional magazines and 67 commercial radio stations, with one nationwide, six national public service radio channels (three in Finnish, two in Swedish, one in Sami); digital radio has three channels.

How has Finland changed the telecommunications industry?

Finland has emerged as a forerunner in mobile data consumption, changing its telecommunications industry. The country's shift towards unlimited data plans has transformed how Finns use their smartphones and access the internet.

How has mobile broadband changed consumer behavior in Finland?

This approach has not only changed consumer behavior but also positioned Finland at the forefront of mobile broadband adoption. The widespread availability of high-speed mobile internet has reshaped household connectivity, with around 97 percent of Finnish homes now enjoying broadband access.
