The levelized cost of electricity (LCOE) for a new utility-scale solar project in Bangladesh ranges from \$97-135/MWh today, compared to \$88-116/MWh for a combined cycle gas turbine (CCGT) and \$110- 50/MWh for a coal power plant. By 2025, solar becomes the cheapest.

The existing renewable energy tariff in Bangladesh is half the cost of electricity generated by oil-fired power plants. Solar power for daytime peak application and evening peak use, supported by two- to three-hour battery backups, will allow the BPDB to significantly lower the power generation.

The government has been generating power from heavy fuel oil (HFO) or furnace oil-run power plants throughout the year despite the production cost of furnace oil-fired electricity being three times higher than other fuels. As a result, a significant portion of the gas and coal-fired power.

Bangladesh's utility electricity sector operates a single national grid, managed by the Power Grid Company of Bangladesh (PGCB), with an installed capacity of 25,700 MW as of June 2022. Bangladesh 's energy sector is not up to the mark. However, per capita energy consumption in Bangladesh is.
