How much does solar panels cost per watt in US dollars

If you just need a few panels for a small do-it-yourself solar project, expect to pay around \$200 to \$350 per panel (between \$0.80 and \$1.40 per watt). Note: The table below doesn't include the cost of a solar storage battery, which can add anywhere from \$7,000 to \$18,000 to your total solar system.

As of 2025, the average cost of residential solar panels in the U.S. is between \$15,000 and \$25,000 before incentives. This typically translates to about \$2.50 to \$3.50 per watt of installed capacity (more on price per watt below). The total price depends on your system size, location, roof type.

To find the most up-to-date solar panel costs in 2025, we compared research from the U.S. Department of Energy and prices from 54 retailers and manufacturers for popular solar panel brands. This chart refers to the average cost range across all common solar system sizes. Cost will vary depending on.

Solar panels cost \$3.00 to \$4.50 per watt installed on average, with homeowners spending about \$3.75 per watt before factoring in available solar incentives. A 6- to 10-kW solar panel installation costs \$12,600 to \$31,500 after the 30% federal tax credit. Solar panel prices depend on the size.

How much does it cost to install and manage solar panels?

According to studies by the U.S. Department of Energy, the all-in cost of a home solar panel system is between \$2.74 to \$3.30 per watt. 1,2,12 This figure includes the solar panels, the installation, and other expenses. Using

these numbers.

The baseline cost of solar panels themselves averages between \$0.75 and \$1.50 per watt, depending on the technology and panel efficiency. This covers just the panel equipment. For a full residential rooftop solar installation, total system costs per watt run approximately \$3.00 to \$4.50 when also.
