How much is the import tariff for new energy storage equipment

The new US import tariffs, including a 10% baseline on all goods and higher rates for key trading partners, such as China, Malaysia, and Vietnam, is expected to have a significant impact on the US battery energy storage industry. In addition to the universal 10%, which is set to be implemented on.

These follow the Biden administration's decision to increase tariffs on lithium batteries from China from 7.5% to 25% starting in January 2026. Alongside this, Trump's review of federal funding and executive orders that steer energy priorities towards oil and gas and energy security could impact.

According to research firm Wood Mackenzie's new report, 'All aboard the tariff coaster: implications for the US power industry,' tariffs on imports will affect battery storage more badly than the solar PV or wind sectors. This is due to

the reliance of the battery energy storage system (BESS).

This past May, the Biden administration announced an increase in Section 301 tariffs on various Chinese imports, including batteries and related components. To better understand the implications of this decision, we sat down with Suzanne Leta, VP of Policy and Advocacy, Americas, at Fluence. In.
