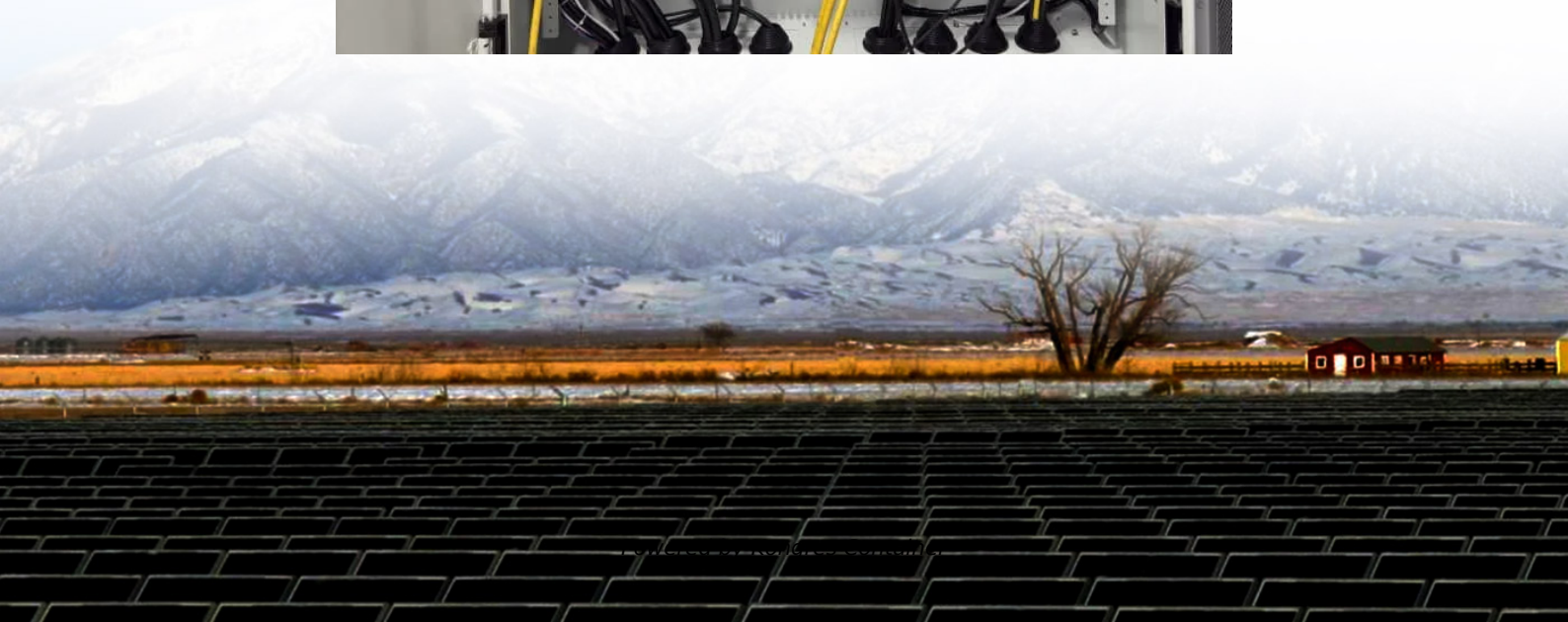

Is Swiss outdoor power supply safe to use



Overview

Typically, type C plug sockets are not allowed to be installed anymore in Switzerland: these outlets are not earthed and are therefore considered dangerous. Only type J power points are permitted because they are grounded and therefore significantly safer.

As our Swiss-army knife of adapters, it can turn 1 Swiss socket into 4 American AC outlets and 3 USB ports, meaning you can charge 7 devices simultaneously and get more juice for your time. This quick-charging ability is ideal for travel since you'll want to get on with your day instead of being.

The Swiss receptacle is unique on the continent in that it IS polarized, but since the type C plug can go in two ways, the polarization can not be assured, making it unsafe to leave an appliance with a polarized plug (one blade wider) plugged in. The type E/F French/German Schuko plug will fit in.

For example, some Type C (Euro) plugs might work, but it's never guaranteed and not recommended. When it comes to powering your devices in Switzerland, not just any adapter will do. Here are your best options:
Dedicated Type J Adapters: For 2024, I highly recommend the Swiss Travel Adapter Pro X7.
