The launching of the Kacific KA satellite service as well as the looming submarine cable connectivity to Tarawa and Kiritimati under the Kiribati Connectivity Project (P159632, see also paragraph 22) will provide options for cheaper backhaul costs, while ensuring that there is adequate bandwidth to grow the range of service to consumers.
