Lesotho Energy Saving New Energy Storage Application



Overview

What is the energy sector like in Lesotho?

The energy sector in Lesotho is characterised by an enormous potential of renewable energy resources. Lesotho has the potential to produce up to 6,000 MW from wind and solar, 4,000 MW from pump storage, 400 MW from conventional hydropower, and more than 1,000 MW from hydropower.

Can Lesotho produce electricity?

Lesotho has the potential to produce up to 6,000 MW from wind and solar, 4,000 MW from pump storage, 400 MW from conventional hydropower, and more than 1,000 MW from hydropower. However, the current demand for electricity continues to exceed supply.

Will Lesotho be able to produce electricity by 2030?

Lesotho has the potential to produce up to 6,000 MW from wind and solar, 4,000 MW from pump storage, 400 MW from conventional hydropower, and more than 1,000 MW from hydropower. Lesotho submitted their first NDC in January 2017 which makes them recognised.

Does Lesotho have a long-term PPA?

The Regulatory Framework for the Development of Renewable Energy Resources in Lesotho (2015) provides an IPP framework with supporting legal instruments to guide in the promotion and facilitation of private investments in renewable energy. However, the report has identified several barriers.

Is Lesotho still lagging behind on energy investment?

In spite of the aforementioned investment incentives that have been formulated by Lesotho, the country is still lagging behind on the key incentives essential for investment in energy i.e. clearly formulated policy targets and incentives such as the REFIT. 3.3.1 Barriers¹⁵.
