# Lesotho purchases mobile energy storage power

Can Lesotho produce electricity?

Renewable energy resources. Lesotho has the potential to produce up to 6,000 MW from wind and solar, 4,000 MW from pump storage, 400 MW from conventional hydropower, and more than 1,000 MW from hydropower. However, the current demand for electricity continues to exceed.

How much energy does Lesotho consume in a year?

Lesotho consumes 501 m kWh of electric energy per year. Per capita, this amounts to an average of 400 kWh. Lesotho can partly be self-sufficient with domestically produced energy, as the total production of all electric energy producing facilities is 501 m kWh, which is 55 percent of the country's own

usage. The rest of the needed energy is imported from foreign countries.
