Myanmar Power Construction Energy Storage Power Station



Overview

Zhefu Holding Group of China and the Myanmar-listed firm Supreme Trading Co. have made plans to invest up to \$2.57 billion to build an LNG import terminal and adjacent gas-fired power station at Mee Laung Gyaing. How can Myanmar improve its power system?

Rebuilding Myanmar's power system will require establishing trust to develop the power sector. Developing solar PV can add incremental generating capacity in a relatively fast manner.

Who manages Myanmar's energy sector?

Myanmar's energy sector is managed by the Ministry of Electric Power (MOEP) and the Ministry of Energy (MOE), which together account for over one-third of public sector revenue. Before May 2022, the two ministries operated under one single Ministry of Electricity and Energy (MOEE).

What happened to power plants in Myanmar?

For these cases, transmission lines or substations connecting those power plants were damaged, gas pipelines to those plants were destroyed, or power plants themselves were temporarily occupied by the resistance force. What is happening in Myanmar's power sector?

Myanmar's power sector has been severely affected by the ongoing political turmoil. The power sector has been spiralling downward since 2021 with prolonged electricity blackouts throughout the country. Electricity generation has been declining, resulting in a widening power supply-demand gap.

While increasing imports could help to ease the electricity supply shortages in Myanmar, it remains challenging under the current circumstances. Improving power sector financial viability and recovering customer confidence are critical for private sector capital mobilization to enhance the quality of electricity services.
