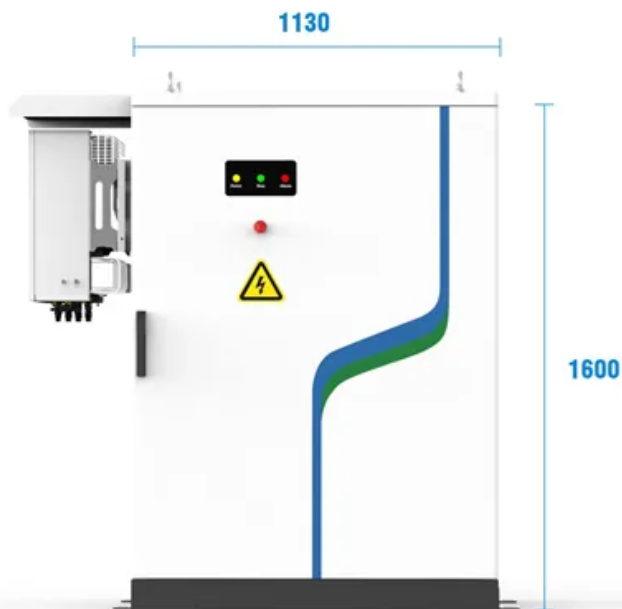

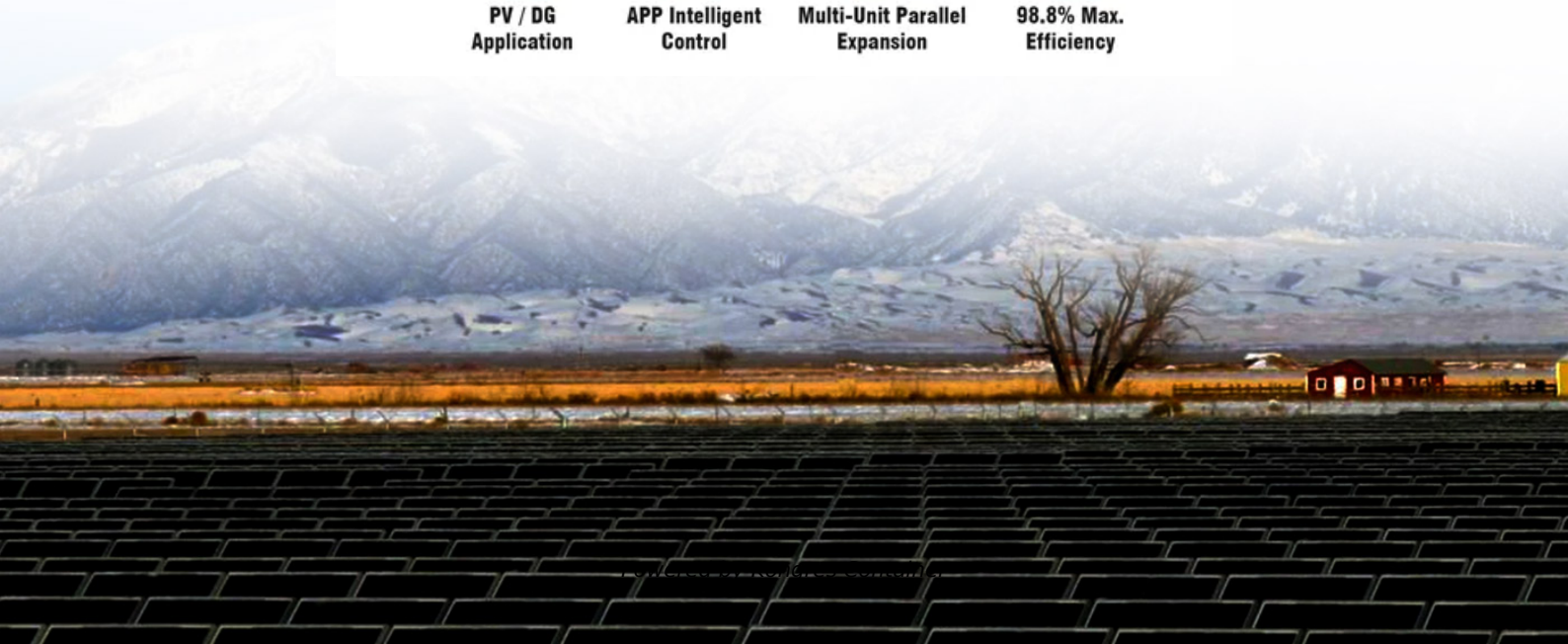

A total of 43 projects were selected from 79 applications in Portugal's 2025 energy storage procurement. This included six projects from Spain's Iberdrola, which secured nearly EUR 20 million in public funding. Portugal's Ministry of Energy has announced that it has allocated EUR 100 million.

Global energy storage platform provider Powin LLC and Galp, Portugal's leading integrated energy company, have partnered to install a utility-scale battery energy storage system (BESS) at one of Galp's solar power plants near Alcoutim, a small village in the country's sunny southern region of the.
