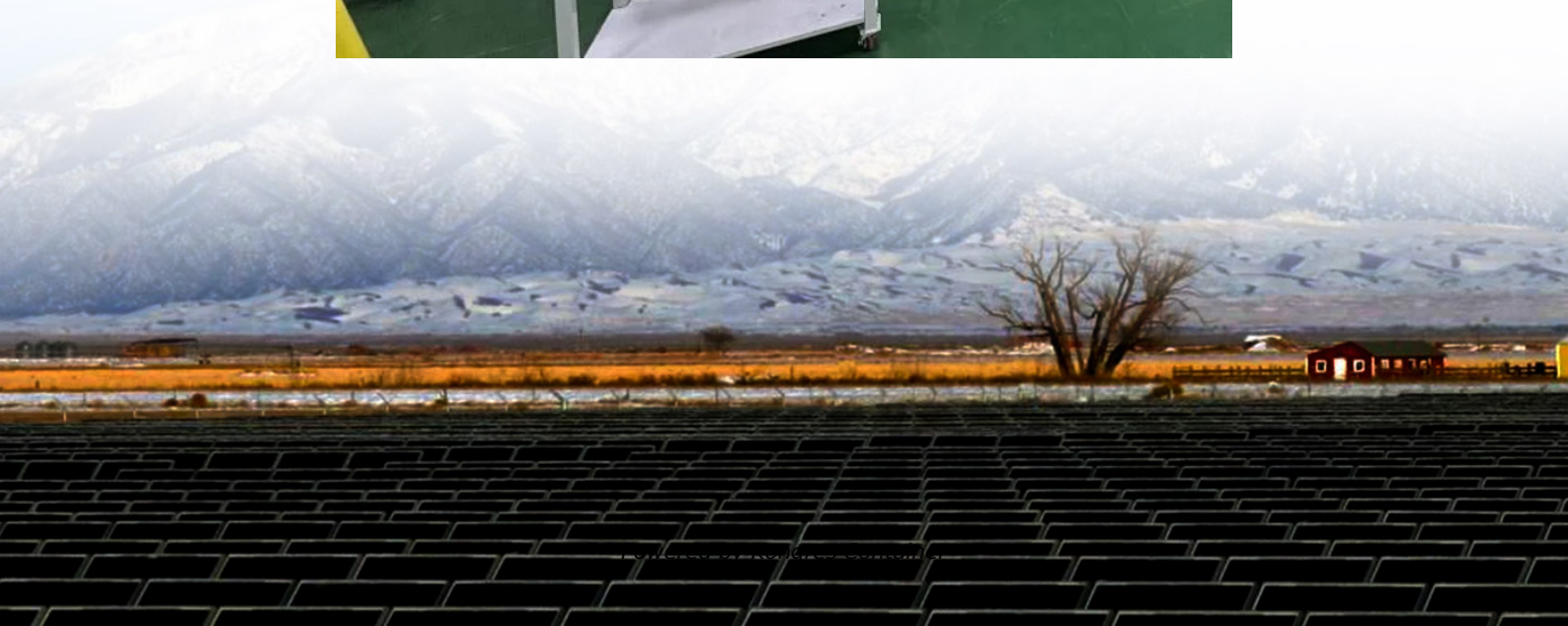

Syria container power generation



Overview

DUBAI (Reuters) - Syria will receive two electricity-generating ships from Turkey and Qatar to boost energy supplies hit by damage to infrastructure during President Bashar al-Assad's rule, state news agency SANA quoted an official as saying on Tuesday. Does Syria have a power shortage?

Syria suffers from severe power shortages, with state-supplied electricity available just two or three hours a day in most areas. The caretaker government says it aims within two months to provide electricity up to eight hours a day. What does Syria's Energy Agreement mean for the economy?

Syria's Minister of Energy, Mohammed Al Bashir, called the agreement "a crucial step" in the country's infrastructure recovery, emphasizing that it will "strengthen our national grid, expand access to electricity, and help meet growing demand." He underscored the importance of international partnerships that align with Syria's national priorities.

How many megawatts of electricity would a ship provide?

Khaled Abu Dai, director general of the General Establishment for Electricity Transmission and Distribution, told SANA the ships would provide a total of 800 megawatts of electricity but did not say over what period.

What is a \$7 billion deal with the Syrian government?

The Syrian government has signed a \$7 billion memorandum of understanding with a consortium of international companies led by Qatar-based UCC Holding to develop major power generation projects, in a deal endorsed by President Ahmed Al-Sharaa.

What is Syria's national infrastructure initiative?

The initiative supports Syria's national goals to rebuild critical infrastructure, strengthen energy security, and drive economic growth.
