Overview

DTEK, Ukraine's largest private energy company, has selected Fluence Energy B.V., a subsidiary of Fluence Energy, Inc. The €140 million total investment aims to enhance power grid stability, bolstering Ukraine's energy security and independence. The project will be the biggest operational energy storage portfolio in Eastern Europe at the time of commissioning.
