As of December 2024, the country aims for solar, wind, and hydropower to cover 54% of its electricity use by 2030. The government has identified several regions — particularly in the northwest, such as the Karakalpakstan region and parts of Navoi and Bukhara — with strong, steady wind currents.

ACWA Power has started full commercial operations of two wind power projects in Uzbekistan. The company announced that the Bash and Dzhankeldy wind farms are now generating electricity. These projects together supply 1 gigawatt (GW) of installed capacity. The wind farms are located in the Bukhara.

In 2021, GoU announced plans to install 7 GW of solar and 5 GW of wind generation capacity by 2030. Demand has been increasing 5% a year on average. The future power system will need to support increasingly complex dynamics in the transition from mainly synchronous to inverter-based resources (IBR).

A new wind power station with a total capacity of 20 megawatts will be built in the Burchmulla area of the Bo'stonliq district of Tashkent region. This was reported by the press service of the Tashkent region administration. The project cost is 28 million US dollars, and construction is planned to.

China's Universal Energy will build in Samarkand and There are two wind

farms with a total capacity of 500 MW in the Jizzakh region. By a decree of the President of Uzbekistan on May 7, investment agreements on construction in the Samarkand and Two-wind power plants in the Jizzakh region.
