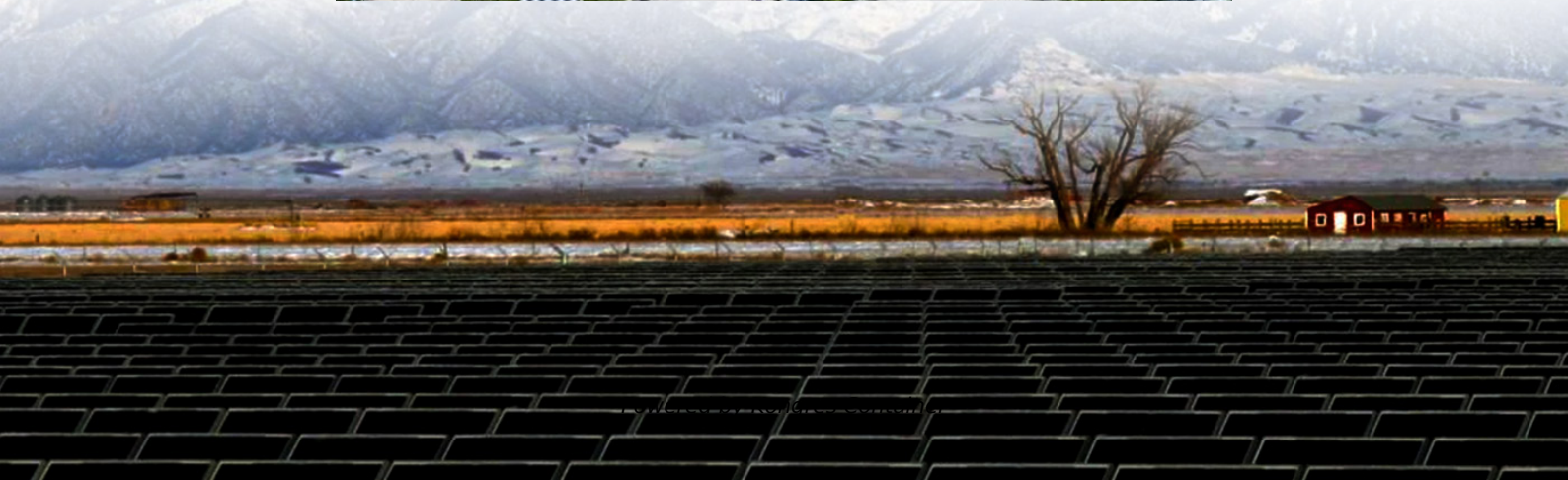

The Partial Deletion Rule (65 FR 55466) allows the EPA to delete portions of NPL sites, provided deletion criteria are met. Partial Deletion proceeds as a normal deletion would, but only for a select portion of the site. Portions of the site may be deleted before others, determined by geographic.

How does a hazardous waste petition work?

The petition is reviewed by the appropriate regulatory agency -- either U.S. EPA or an authorized state hazardous waste regulatory agency -- to determine whether the waste should continue to be listed as hazardous.

Can hazardous waste be delisted?

RCRA regulations provide a petition procedure to exclude or "delist" a particular facility's waste from the list of hazardous wastes if the waste does not possess the dangerous properties. While there are two general types of hazardous waste, characteristic and listed, only listed wastes can be delisted.

How do I find EPA facilities that successfully petitioned EPA for a delisting?

To look up the facilities that successfully petitioned EPA for a delisting, view the Appendix IX of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations part 261.
