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Which is the largest energy storage project in Mozambique



Overview

Mozambique's government is expected to launch the \$7.2 billion Coral Norte LNG project in October, one of Africa's largest. The project will be unveiled next month in the Rovuma Basin's Area 4 as announced by President Daniel Chapo. He noted this during the Global Energy Alliance.
